APPLICATION GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must be a current, full time undergraduate student at Texas A&M University College Station or Galveston carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours. Graduate students are not eligible. Scholarship recipients must also be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours when the scholarship is awarded in Fall 2021.
- 2. Applicants must have *completed* 45 credit hours at an accredited college or university with a minimum of 12 credit hours in one semester at Texas A & M University College Station or Texas A & M University Galveston by the end of the Fall 2020 semester. Students who do not meet the criteria are **not eligible** to apply, but are encouraged to apply at a later date.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum overall GPR of 2.50.
- 4. Applicants must NOT be a recipient of:
 - > a prior Katy/West Houston Texas A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship
 - > a Katy/West Houston Aggie Mothers' Club Endowed Opportunity Award
 - a four-year academic scholarship awarded by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.
- 5. Permanent residential address must be in the following zip codes: 77079, 77084, 77094, 77423, 77433, 77441, 77449, 77450, 77493, and 77494.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for the 2021-2022 school year
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by email by May 4, 2021. The recipient(s) will be announced and recognized at the Katy/West Houston Aggie May General Meeting.

APPLICATION	PROCEDURE:
1.	*Complete the attached application IN FULL. No resumes will be accepted.
2.	*Enclose a signed and completed copy of the Biographical Information Cover Sheet.
3.	*Enclose the ORIGINAL and THREE (3) COPIES of the completed Scholarship Application . The applicant's University Identification Number must appear in the upper right-hand corner of each page of the original and of all three copies.
4.	*One <u>unofficial</u> transcript from Texas A&M University Office of Admissions and Records that includes the Fall 2020 semester to verify your credit hours and GPR (Criteria 2 and 3 under Eligibility) is required. Please allow enough time to ensure that it will be RECEIVED by the deadline, April 1, 2021.
	For students who are selected as scholarship winners, an <u>Official transcript</u> will be <u>required</u> and must be sent directly from the Registrar to the address given below so that funds may be released to your student account at Texas A & M. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email. Official transcripts will be due within one week following that notification. Failure to do so will cause forfeiture of the scholarship.
5.	*Enclose your Student Schedule for Spring 2021 to verify that you are currently a full time student at Texas A&M University College Station or Galveston carrying the minimum 12 hours (Criteria 1 under Eligibility). Use the Student Information System (My Records) site at http://myrecord.tamu.edu to print this schedule.
