Our new Executive Board will be installed at the May General Meeting. Working with the Executive Board are Committee Chairs that are appointed by the President and help our Club carry out its mission. We are looking for help on the Committees listed below:

- **Ways and Means** – plan and arrange for the raising of funds for the Club through fundraisers and sale of merchandise at the annual Federation of Aggie Mother's Clubs Boutique. Ideally served by Co-Chairs and committee members.
- **Ring Crest Chair** – orders Ring Crests from our supplier in College Station and mails or distributes to the buyers. Sends an email to all Federation Club Presidents before Boutique in April to solicit sales. Recognize August, December and May graduates in the corresponding month by presenting with a Ring Crest to graduates of active Club members.
- **Get Giggled Chair** – ideally served by Co-Chairs. Solicits sale of Get Giggled and Aggie Bound sign sets and sets up and takes down the sets after an event.
- **Social Committee Chair** - coordinates Club social events that occur outside of the general meetings (examples: Book Club, Bunko, Field Trips, art opportunities such as Painting with a Twist, etc.)
- **Scholarship Committee Chair** – notify Club members when the application is available (December) and evaluates applications and selects recipients, notifies recipients and invites them and their families to the May general meeting to be recognized. Assisted by a Committee that is appointed by the President in March.
- **Hospitality Committee Chair** – make arrangements for refreshments and mans the table at the monthly meetings and special events. Publishes monthly Sign Up Genius to solicit goodies.
- **Publicity Committee** – help Publicity Chair post Club news to social media and prepare and distribute a monthly newsletter
- **Care Package Committee** – help Care Package Chair distribute Care Packages to students near the end of Fall and Spring semesters.
